EXECUTIVE SUMMARY AND PURPOSE OF REPORT		
National funding was provided in 2013/14 and made available in 2014/15 to the East Midlands Regional PCCs, to purchase an additional discreet building within the region for relocation of existing 5 force collaborative resources. This enables co-location with the National Crime Agency, in line with the national and regional strategy and is a natural extension of a joint approach to crime collaboration in the East Midlands.		
RECOMMENDATION	<p>That the PCC:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Approves the purchase (together with East Midlands PCCs) of the discreet building at the net purchase price of £700,000. 2. That the purchase and associated conversion costs of the existing and new discreet buildings be met from the national funding provided.

A1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

Regional PCCs have discussed this on a number of occasions since May 2014, including the options. A number of further meetings have explored these options and costs and agreement was indicated by the Regional PCCs at their meeting on the 17th June 2014 to purchase the discreet building, to be met from the national funding allocation provided and for conversion and adaptations to be within clear criteria. A regional PCC representative attends the Project Board meetings to provide oversight and input from a PCC perspective.

Regional collaboration is a core element of the PCC's Police and Crime Plan.
